
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT the Final Fairness Hearing, previously set for Thursday, February 15, 2024 at 9:30 a.m. by Zoom video conference, is rescheduled to Tuesday, **March 26, 2024** at 9:30 a.m. by Zoom video conference.¹

¹ The invitation to the Zoom meeting will be filed as a separate docket entry and will be viewable only by the parties. The attorneys shall advise settlement class members in the notice that any other person wishing to appear and be heard by Zoom must contact the Court 14 days prior to the hearing to receive the Zoom information. Otherwise, the hearing will be broadcasted live on the Court's website. The Court asks that all participants log in to the Zoom conference five minutes prior to

Plaintiffs' motion for final approval of class action settlement, for attorneys' fees, costs and expenses, and on behalf of the class representative for a service award, as set forth in the Settlement Agreement, shall be filed by March 15, 2024.

Lastly, class counsel and/or defense counsel may file and serve a written response to any objections by March 21, 2024.
